In order to more easily track arts economic impact data for North Carolina, we are requiring all applicants (who have not already done so) to register with Dun and Bradstreet (D&B) and be issued a DUNS (Data Universal Numbering System) number. Analysis of arts economic data suggests that the nonprofit sector is underrepresented in the D&B database. So Americans for the Arts asks your help to make sure that your own organization is listed and properly coded, AND that all **nonprofit arts organizations** and **artists** have a D&B number.

DUNS numbers are also required by the National Endowment for the Arts and other Federal grant programs. There is no fee for registering for a DUNS number. You may register by phone or online.
