

Thank you for your interest in Introduction to Acrylic Painting with Fabrizio Bianchi.

Here is a list of the supplies you will need for class:

- Acrylic Paint (avoid student grade! Liquitex Basics are ok, heavy body paints are better):
 - Titanium White, Cadmium Red, Alizarin Crimson or Quinacridone Red, Cadmium Yellow, Cobalt Blue, Ultramarine Blue, Burnt Umber, Phthalo Green, and Mars Black
- Paint brushes – small set with a variety of sizes – Preferably rounds and flats (synthetic bristles hold better with acrylics)
- Bristol Board Pad or canvas paper pad, preferably 16" x 20" in size
- Supports for your paintings – we will start with the Bristol board or canvas paper, but feel free to get at least a couple canvas boards or canvas (no smaller than 11" x 14")
- Medium flexible metal Palette knife (plastic knives are fine)
- Palette (can be glass, plastic, or palette paper as long as it's a flat surface – not the white kind with little cups for paint to sit in)
- Water cup (this doesn't need to be fancy. Any recycled plastic container will do)
- Pencil and eraser for quick sketches
- Ruler
- Painter's tape
- Rags (old t-shirts work well)
- Small Spray Bottle
- Hand Soap – liquid preferable
- Apron or shirt to wear while painting
- Rubber gloves if you want to keep your hands cleaner
- Toolbox to hold all supplies

Note: This list may be subject to change based on how the lessons go. If you have questions on any supplies you may already have, or wondering about what to purchase.

Try to avoid buying from Michael's and other chain stores (more expensive, not as much variety). Order your paints and other supplies online if possible (or go to places like Jerry's Artarama in Raleigh):

You'll come down the side street, Allison St./Eno Mountain Rd., depending on which direction you're coming from, and turn down the driveway directly in front of the smokestack. Turn right into the Lower Level Parking Lot, and you'll see our space about half way down the walkway. There are two handicapped accessible parking spaces directly in front of the ramp that leads onto the walkway in front of our suite. Please enter through the 2nd door with the Orange County Arts Commission sign.
